At first, it sounded like a discordant chord in the martial music of God's judgment. And then its happy melody begins to drown out his fear and horror. He was surprised and elated when he realized who was the Singer.

"The LORD your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing" (Zephaniah 3:17).

Have you ever thought of God as a singer? As One who sings love song to you, his child? The psalmists heard God singing when life was dark and their their hopes darker. "I wonder, 'Will I ever make it— arrive and drink in God's presence?' I'm on a diet of tears— tears for breakfast, tears for supper" (Psalm 42:2-3, MESSAGE).
