Instead, He entrusted Himself to Him who judges justly” (1 Peter 2:23).

Jesus endured injustice from men so that he could do what you and I cannot do: pay for our sins. At the cross God judged us justly by punishing Jesus for our sins.

“For He made Him (Christ) who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him” (2 Corinthians 5:21).

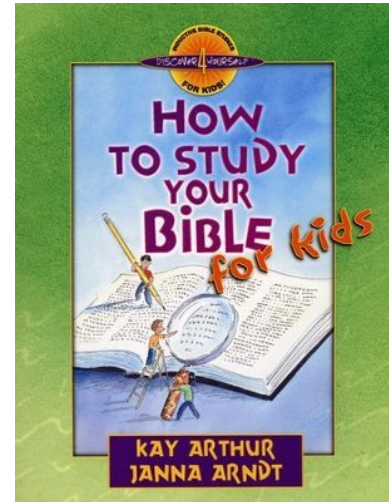
