The beautiful flowers that defy the still stark winter landscape reminded me of what the Lord Jesus said, “... do not worry about your life” (Matthew 6:25);

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“And why do you worry about clothes? See how the flowers of the field grow. They do not labor or spin. Yet I tell you that not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, will he not much more clothe you—you of little faith?” (Matthew 6:28-30);

A question the Lord Jesus raises is a question we should take to heart.

“Can any one of you by worrying add a single hour to your life?” (Matthew 6:27).

If I could trust Jesus Christ for my eternal salvation I certainly can trust him for my physical life and all the needs I have for today.

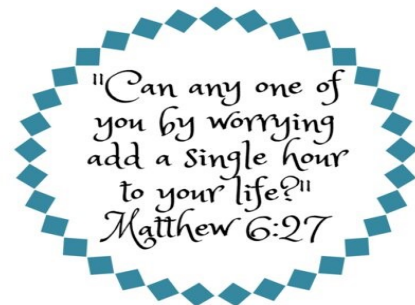
